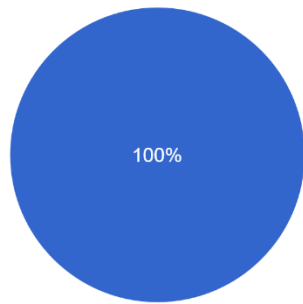


Are you pleased with the progress your child is making at school?

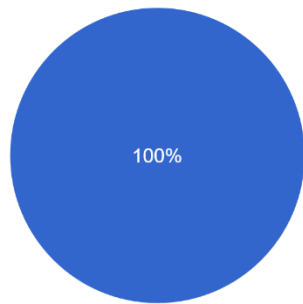

Do you feel that school keeps you informed about your child's progress?

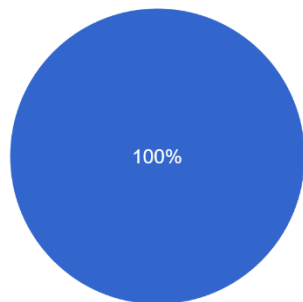

Do you feel that you are able to approach staff if you have concerns or questions regarding your child?

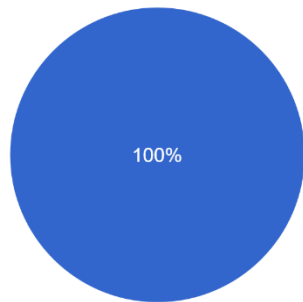

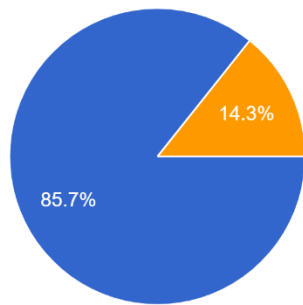

Does your child enjoy coming to school?

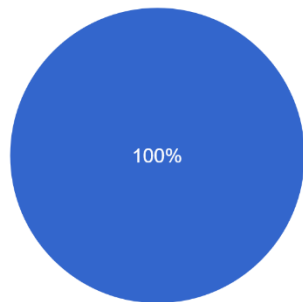

Do you feel they are happy and safe?

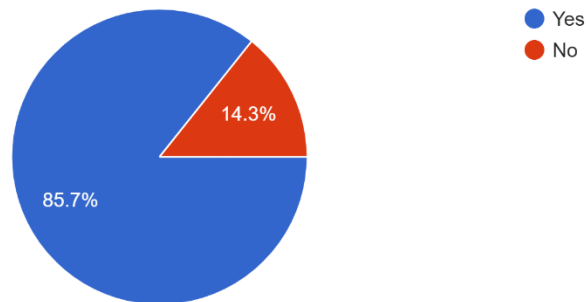

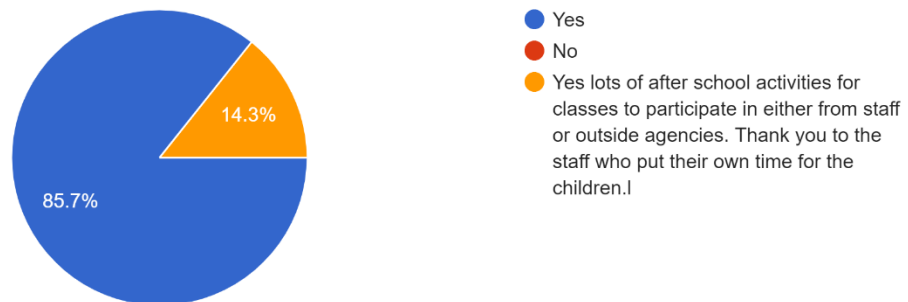
Do you know what level of support your child receives in school? e.g SEN support, EHCP

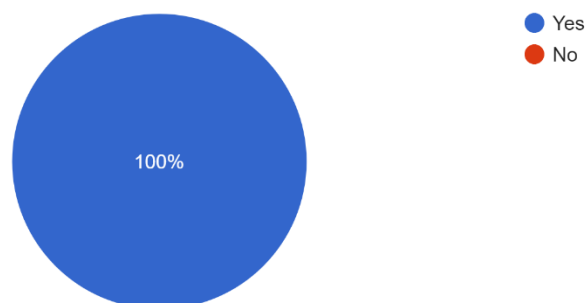
Do you feel that your child is given the opportunity to be included in all extra-curricular activities, visits and clubs?

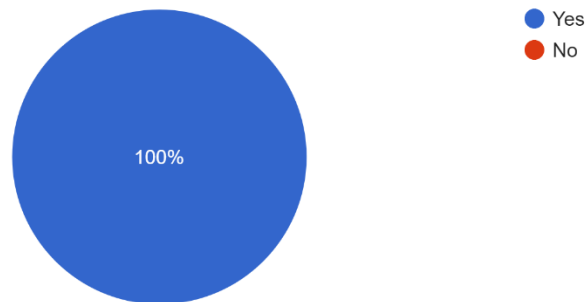
Do you feel that the school's policy on SEN (on the website/app) is clear and accessible?
