Dear Parents/Guardians,

Happy New Year to all. I hope you have all had an enjoyable Christmas and are ready for our new term. The children have returned to school happily and are showing great excitement about our new topic of 'Superhero's'

We will be looking at the different areas the children chose to play in and will be developing their play and interactions and conversations with each other. We will explore friendships and link into feelings and how to solve any problems. As always please feel free to chat to us each morning or evening and if you would like to speak to us feel free to arrange a time to do so.
